This list of externship opportunities represents government and public interest law offices where University of La Verne law students have externed from the summer of 2013 to the present. These locations are pre-approved. In order to secure an externship, you must apply through the individual organizations. Those not on this list may still be eligible for externship credit, but must be approved by the Director of Experiential Learning, Diane Uchimiya.
