Monday, January 7, 2019: read pages 9 – 31. Read the Examples, hypotheticals that illustrate the principles being discussed. Access TWEN and go to “Forum” then “Discussion”. I have posted an agency hypothetical which you are to be prepared to discuss in class. I highly recommend you do the CALI lessons on Agency.

Wednesday, January 9, 2019: read pages 33 – 48. Prepare written briefs for Smith v. Kelly, Summers v. Dooley, and National Biscuit Co. v. Stroud.

While we will compare the Revised Uniform Partnership Act (RUPA) with the original UPA, our focus will be on RUPA as embodied in California Corporations Code sections 16100 et seq. Cross-reference the casebook's references to RUPA as follows: RUPA section 201 is found in Ca.Corp.Code section 16201.

It is critically important that you read all applicable statutes as Business Organizations is a statute based discipline.
